ADEM Celebrates Earth Day

Approximately 200 students participated in ADEM's Earth Day event

The Alabama Department of Environmental Management hosted a special Earth Day event on April 11 with approximately 200 middle school students visiting the Central Offices in Montgomery.

The celebration enabled the students to visit ADEM and learn about the environmental programs implemented on a daily basis to protect and preserve Alabama's natural resources. The students watched up-close demonstrations and learned about a wide-range of environmental programs including fish tissue monitoring, water quality sampling, air monitoring, recycling, hazardous waste

disposal, and efforts to ensure that clean, safe drinking water is provided for all Alabamians.

ADEM staff provided support and worked hard to make the effort a success illustrating that at ADEM. "every day is Earth Day." More than 65 departmental employees gave the students opportunities to learn about careers at ADEM, and encouraged the students to pursue science-related fields of study.

The following schools were represented this year: CAMO Kids from Bullock County, Alabama Christian Academy, Goodwyn Middle School, Millbrook Middle School, and Brewbaker Middle School. 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


