





FY23 Eligibility Chart for Multiple Applications




Region 4 Grant - Food for Thought

- Region 4 has demonstrated tremendous success with assessment grants
 - National shift towards cleanups (new direction!)
 - Think about Coalition RLFs
- Existing grantees compete into the smallest pool for community-wide assessment grants
- Need to knock on new doors
- Consultant hiring: consider hiring 2 and complete the work in 3 years (but optional)



RLFs: The Long Game

- Not your 2020 RLF grant....
- <u>New Rule</u>: once awarded, no more application for funds needed
- Can close the RLF after a few years and use Revolved funds for Assessments
- Coalition RLFs large geographic areas

State/Tribal Funding

PA BROWNFIELDS AND LAND REVITALIZATION

- States/Tribes run the cleanup operation at each site:
 - Cleanup oversight (Voluntary Cleanup Contracts)
 - Cleanup certification (No Further Action)
 - Voluntary Cleanup Program financial incentives (rebates, tax credits)
- State Response Programs + Assessment, Revolving Loan Fund grants (NC, MS, KY)
 - AL & SC have RLFs and are applying for FY 23 assessment (CWAGST)
 - FL, GA, TN have BIL and Regular Appropriation 128(a)
- Additional funding is meeting unmet needs some hiring, some software/inventory system updates, etc.
- New strategies & new messaging with BIL funding
