Good Afternoon,

This message is being sent to the Contaminated Media Forum distribution list. I'm using the GovDelivery system for the first time, so I'm interested in how well this works.

We have posted a number of draft updates to the Institutional Control Procedures Guidance (ICPG) document to the ICPG website (<u>https://floridadep.gov/waste/waste/content/institutional-controls-procedures-guidance</u>) for review and comment. You'll see the documents posted at the top of the page along with a requested timeframe for review. We've also set up a mailbox specifically for ICPG comments (<u>ICPG@FloridaDEP.gov</u>) so the entire ICPG team will have access to them.

There are two general groups of documents:

1. The first is an update to several existing ICPG sections or attachments and these are posted with both a 'clean' version and a 'track changes' version. Although the track changes versions are very difficult to read they do provide a snapshot of the edits made, some explanatory notes, and some items for further discussion. ICPG sections C.1, C.2, C.11, C.17 and Attachments 9A and 9D are in this group of documents.

2. The other group of documents is a change to the procedure for approval for wells, stormwater features and dewatering at sites closed with a groundwater use restriction. The proposal is to switch from having DEP approve post-closure activities, to requiring a Florida-registered professional engineer or Florida-registered professional geologist certify the proposed activity, and to provide a certified copy of that plan to DEP. We've drafted an updated Conditional Site Rehabilitation Completion Order and a copy of Attachment 3 from the ICPG so you can see what the language might look like in context. I'm sure there are other supporting documents that will need to be updated as well.
