### LEGISLATIVE REPORT

### 2022 General Election

While nationally, there may have only been a red "ripple," – Florida witnessed a red tsunami. There are six statewide elected offices, and all are solidly Republican – meaning Democrats will not have a statewide elected official for the first time in modern history. Florida's U.S. delegation is now comprised of 20 Republicans and 8 Democrats. Incoming Senate President Kathleen Passidomo will have the first Republican super-majority in 12 years (28 Republicans, 12 Democrats), having won all three of her battleground, targeted seats (SD 3, SD 14, SD 38). Similarly, incoming Speaker of the House Paul Renner will also enjoy a super-majority of his legislative body (85 Republicans, 35 Democrats) –for the first time since 2010. The average margin of victory in top-of-the-ticket races in Florida since 1992 has been under 1%. Senator Rubio and Governor DeSantis each won by nearly 20%.

In the General Election, there were two incumbents who were defeated in the Senate (Senators Ausley and Cruz), and the House is also losing two members (Representatives Carlos Guillermo Smith and Andrew Learned) – all Democrats. The Senate will have 13 new members, and the House will welcome 41 newly-elected freshmen. Please refer to the 2022-2024 House and Senate Members tab for a complete list of the current legislative body.

With the 2022 Elections behind them, House and Senate candidates will now set their sights on 2024. Seven current Senators will be term-limited, so we expect some political jockeying amongst incumbent House members vying for those seats.

### **Organizational Session**

The House and Senate convened for the constitutionally-mandated but largely ceremonial Organizational Session on Tuesday, November 22, to swear in new members and officially install the new presiding officers. Palm Coast Republican Paul Renner, an attorney and Navy Veteran, was sworn in as Speaker of the House of Representatives, while Kathleen Passidomo, an attorney from Naples, became the third female Senate President to lead the chamber in the state's 177-year history.

In their opening day remarks, each presiding officer outlined some of their legislative priorities for the upcoming session. Speaker Renner announced the creation of a Select Committee on Hurricane Resiliency and Recovery to help the state rebound from Hurricane Ian and Hurricane Nicole and to prepare for future storms. He also announced his intention to address rising inflation rates and other cost-of-living issues such as insurance, housing, taxes, fuel, and electricity.

Similarly, President Passidomo – whose home was damaged by Hurricane Ian – also wants to focus on pocketbook issues. In her speech, she stated, "As we look to the future, Florida's economy is in great shape. Our unemployment rate is a full point below the national rate. The Sunshine State is on track for record growth this year. However, while Florida's economy is booming, the pain of inflation is very real for Florida families. We see it at the grocery store. We see it at the gas pump. And we certainly see it in the housing market." She is also working on legislation that would tie financial incentives to mixed-use housing, and seeks to expand Florida's existing wildlife corridor.

### **Committee Announcements**

In the weeks following Organizational Session, leadership appointments were announced, and House and Senate committee structure and assignments were made. President Designate Kathleen Passidomo announced her leadership team, including Senator Dennis Baxley as President Pro Tempore and President-Designate Ben Albritton as Majority Leader. Rounding out her inner circle will be Senators Travis Hutson, Debbie Mayfield, Doug Broxson, and Keith Perry. Leading the Democrats will be Senator Minority Leader Lauren Book, and Senator Jason Pizzo will serve as her Deputy Minority Leader.

House leadership includes Representative Chuck Clemons as Speaker Pro Tempore. Representative Mike Grant will serve as Majority Leader, John Snyder as Deputy Majority Leader, and Representative Adam Botana serving as Majority Whip. Minority Leader Fentriss Driskell has appointed Representative Dotie Joseph as Deputy Minority Leader and Christine Hunschofsky as Minority Whip.

In the House, full panel rosters were released for the nine main committees, 23 subcommittees, five joint committees, and the Select Committee on Hurricane Resiliency & Recovery. Ormond Beach Republican Tom Leek was appointed as Chair of the House Appropriations Committee, while Ocala Republican Stan McClain will assume the Finance and Tax Committee chairmanship.

The Senate committee structure saw fewer changes from the prior year. The Education Policy committee was been divided into two separate committees – one for PreK-12 and one for post-secondary – and the creation of a new Fiscal Policy committee which will be chaired by Senator Hutson. Leading the Senate Appropriations Committee is panhandle Republican Doug Broxson, and Spring Hill Republican Blaise Ingoglia will serve as Chair of the Senate Finance & Tax Committee.

### **Special Session A**

On December 6, Speaker Renner and President Passidomo signed and issued a proclamation formally convening the Legislature into a special session during the week of December 12 – December 16, which was previously scheduled to be the first interim committee week of the 2023 Legislative Session.

While specific legislation has yet to be introduced, the House and Senate will address curbing costs of lawsuits over insurance claims, boosting the availability of reinsurance, limiting assignment of benefits, and financially stabilizing Citizens. Also included in the call will be tax relief and other assistance for people who sustained damage in Hurricanes Ian and Nicole.

### On the Horizon

Additionally, we will reach out to the Governor's Office of Policy and Budget and the Director of Policy and Budget Chris Spencer.

Additionally, we are working with FBA members to identify dates for a potential legislative day, to allow FBA members to come to Tallahassee and meet with many of the Legislators – both incumbents and freshman – who may not be familiar with the Association and its priorities.
